

Antonina Pakharenko-Anderson, LLD

Antonina Pakharenko-Anderson is the Managing Partner and founder of one of the first private intellectual property and law firms in Ukraine, Pakharenko & Partners (1994). She is a registered Patent Attorney and Doctor of Laws who has been working in the field of intellectual property for over 25 years.

She graduated from the Kyiv Polytechnic University (MS, electrical engineer), Moscow Central Institute of Intellectual Property (patent specialist) and the Academy of International Personnel Development in Kyiv (JD; LLD).

As the President of the Ukraine Alliance Against Counterfeiting and Piracy (UAACP) and a member of several international anti-counterfeiting coalitions, she provides assistance to businesses in tackling counterfeiting and piracy problems in Ukraine.

She is the President of the Ukrainian National Group of AIPPI and a member of the Ukrainian Patent Attorneys Association.

Dr. Pakharenko's experience in consultancy on the national level includes serving as a Consultant to the Education and Science Committee of the Ukrainian parliament. Dr. Pakharenko-Anderson has taken active part in the continuing development of the Ukrainian intellectual property laws. She has also delivered a number of speeches at parliamentary hearings dedicated to IPR enforcement.

Antonina Pakharenko-Anderson is a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the Supreme Commercial Court of Ukraine (the higher court instance in the system of commercial courts of Ukraine), a consultative body whose tasks include preparation of scientific recommendations on draft resolutions of the Supreme Commercial Court which require scientific analysis; studying and contributing to cumulative analysis of application of substantive and procedure laws by commercial courts for the purpose of unification of judicial practices ensuring that justice is executed in accordance with international standards.

For an extended period of time she served as the Head of the Public Council under the State Department of Intellectual Property of Ukraine (now the State Service for Intellectual Property of Ukraine), an advisory body under the Ukrainian IPR Office.

On an international level, Dr. Pakharenko has been active with a number of international governmental and non-governmental organisations in the IP field, particularly in the operations of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UN/ECE). Before its re-organisation in 2007, Antonina Pakharenko-Anderson was Co-Chair of the UN/ECE Advisory Committee on IP Protection for

Investment. Currently she is a member of the Team of Specialists of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (TOS UN/ECE).

Dr. Pakharenko-Anderson and her company are involved in the activity of the following international organisations in the IP field: AIPPI, LES, FICPI, INTA, MARQUES, ECTA, PTMG, ACG, GACG, IACC, ICC/CIB, ACC, EBA, IBA.

Dr. Pakharenko-Anderson is a co-author of several books dedicated to the protection and enforcement of IP in Ukraine, and an author of a number of articles on intellectual property matters published in international IP editions.

Dr. Pakharenko-Anderson serves as a panellist at National Arbitration Forum handling disputes under the UDRP procedure since 2008.

She speaks Ukrainian, Russian, English, German
